### Player Code of Conduct

Players on all GVIHC teams represent Great Valley School District on and off the ice. As such, they are to conduct themselves in a positive and disciplined manner which will reflect favorably on our hockey club and the school district

- Players must maintain academic and financial eligibility as outlined by the GVIHC, and the Great Valley School District.
- The player should be on time for all practices and games.
- The player should be prepared to give his/her best effort during all practices and games.
- The player should listen when coaches or team representatives are speaking.
- The player should follow the coaches' on-ice instructions.
- The player should recognize that insubordination will not be tolerated.
- Treat your teammates, coaches, team representatives and others with the respect.
- The player should attempt to be a positive influence on his/her teammates. Encourage others on the team and refrain from making negative or derogatory comments to teammates.
- The player should be committed to helping with team fundraisers during the year.
- The player should obey all team and club rules and regulations.
- The player must agree to abide by the Discipline Code.

### Player's Discipline Code

The following infractions by a player will be sufficient cause for disciplinary action that could result in dismissal from the Club:

- Use and/or possession of illegal drugs.
- Drinking alcoholic beverages of any type.
- Smoking.
- Stealing property or equipment.
- Malicious destruction or damage of any property, including locker rooms, meeting rooms, or any place used by the club for any club function.
- Missing scheduled games without the coach's permission.
- Continued absence from practice.
- Insubordination.
- Failure to follow the uniform code.
